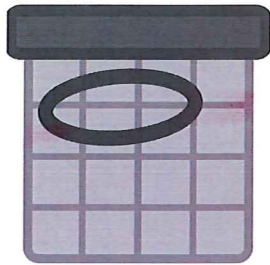

Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

Doors will unlock at 7:30 am and classes begin at 7:45 am. All students will be directed to their classrooms this year, unless they are eating a student breakfast. Grades K - 2 will eat breakfast in the cafeteria. Grades 3-6 will eat breakfast in the classroom. Please make sure your child arrives in plenty of time before the bell rings.

Students should always be dropped off and picked up in the west parking lot. Busses load and unload in front of the school, so please help keep it free. No parents will be allowed to enter the building before or after school. Before school, please loop around in the west parking lot, and let your child out at the sidewalk. **New this year**, for safety reasons, parents will not be allowed to wait in the vestibule after school. Parents should remain in their vehicles and all pick-up students will be escorted to the parking lot to be picked up there after the busses leave.

Meal Procedures

Prices for this year's meals are as follows...

Breakfast: \$1.75 Lunch: \$ 2.25 Extra Milk \$ 0.40

School policy states that students owing more than 5 days (\$ 11.25 full-pay, \$ 2.00 reduced pay) will not be served a school meal. In the event that an account is overdrawn the maximum amount, the child will be served a ham sandwich and a carton of milk. Students will not be able to phone home for meal money or a sack lunch. Weekly notices will be sent home with students when their accounts are overdrawn. You may also check your child's balance through Harmony Access. Applications for assistance are available in this office.
